

FREO BUILDS 2023 | Terms and conditions

General conditions of entry:

- 1. This document and the instructions on how to enter the "Freo Builds School Competition" and "Freo Builds Trail" form part of these terms and conditions.
- 2. Employees of the City of Fremantle and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition.
- 3. Participating partner business owners and their staff are not eligible to enter the competition.
- 4. If for any reason any aspect of this Promotion is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of computer virus, communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion and invalidate any affected entries, or suspend or modify a prize.
- 5. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to validate and check the authenticity of entries and entrant's details (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence). In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof as required by the Promoter to validate their entry, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered. Freo Builds School Competition

Conditions of entry:

- 1. Entry period: Monday 8th May to 2pm Thursday 25th May 2023.
- 2. A child must choose from one of the six (6) Fremantle locations:
 - a. Fishing Boat Harbour
 - b. Fremantle Beaches
 - c. Fremantle Library
 - d. Fremantle Oval
 - e. Esplanade Reserve
 - f. Fremantle Port
- 3. A child will imagine how one of the six locations could look 50 years from now and draw it by hand or via a sketch app on the iPad.
- 4. Upon parent or legal guardian consent, complete the Freo Builds School Competition entry form and place the entry in the entry box at Toyworld Fremantle, Fremantle Visitor Centre or email it to schoolholidays@fremantle.wa.gov.au.
- 5. Eligible entrants: Entry is open to WA primary school students from kindergarten to year six during the competition period.



- 6. Entrants must have parent or legal guardian approval to enter.
- 7. A panel of four judges nominated by the City of Fremantle will choose up to six (6) finalists as per the selection criteria on Friday 26th May 2023 announced on THIS IS FREMANTLE website by 5pm Friday 26th May 2023.
- 8. Selection criteria:
 - a. The judges will be looking for entries that demonstrate creativity and imagination in showing the future of the chosen location.
 - b. The judges shall at their sole discretion select the six (6) finalists based on the selection criteria.
- 9. Only one entry may be received per eligible entrant.
- 10. Each eligible entry must be unique.
- 11. City of Fremantle reserves the right to not approve or exclude any entrant for any reason it sees fit in its absolute discretion.
- 12. The six (6) finalists will be contacted by the City of Fremantle by 5pm on Friday 26th May 2023.
- 13. The six (6) finalists designs will be recreated in LEGO[®] by six local LEGO[®] builders nominated by the City of Fremantle. The LEGO[®] builds will be on display during the 'Freo Builds Trail' promotional period.
- 14. LEGO® builds:
 - a. The six (6) LEGO® builders will be selected by the City of Fremantle.
 - b. The LEGO® builds to reflect and be inspired by the child's design.
 - c. LEGO® build to fit in a standard showcase as specified by City of Fremantle.
 - d. Copyright remains with the artists however by entering into the competition you give the City of Fremantle permission to use the artwork and 3D LEGO[®] designs in any way, and the rights to use and reproduce the artwork indefinitely.
 - e. Builds incorporating custom lighting kits and power functions will not be accepted.
 - f. The six (6) LEGO® builds presented by the nominated builders for the 'Freo Builds Trail' is final and approved at the discretion of City of Fremantle.
- 15. During the 'Freo Builds Trail' promotional period the public will be encouraged to vote for their favourite design and LEGO[®] build.

Freo Builds Trail

Conditions of entry:

- 1. Freo Builds Trail promotional period: the trail commences at 10am (AWST) on Thursday 6 July 2023 and closes at 4pm (AWST) on Wednesday 12 July 2023.
- 2. Eligible entrants for the trail: Entry is open to WA residents. Entrants under the age of 12 must have parent or legal guardian approval to enter.
- 3. As part of the promotion, a limited number of various LEGO® toys are available free of charge (LEGO® poly bags and Stunt range from \$6 to \$10 RRP). While stocks last. The free LEGO® toys are only available for children under 12 years.
- 4. The Freo Builds Trail map and entry forms can be collected from the start location selected during the ticket registration process (Fremantle Visitor Centre or WA Maritime Museum).
